3 To agree a response to Aylesbury Vale District Council in respect of Planning Application Reference 12/01806/APP - Construction, operation and decommissioning of single 3 bladed wind turbine with maximum height to tip of blade of 101.5 metres and associated infrastructure including new highways access, access tracks, temporary site compound, crane pad and substation.

The application was discussed and the following statement was agreed to be submitted to AVDC via the planning portal.

Great and Little Kimble cum Marsh Parish Council write to object to application 12/01806/APP on the basis that the development is harmful to the environment and is likely to have a negative impact on the local residents. We support the principle of renewable energy, however, this development in the heart of the Vale of Aylesbury will be visible from various vistas within the area and Chiltern Hills, and as such would seem to be an inappropriate location. We also question the viability of a single turbine and consider that this development, if approved, would set an unwanted precedent for future expansion of the site.
