## 4 Planning Applications and appeals review and confirm the responses made to Wycombe District Council by the planning committee (An updated list will be circulated before the meeting)

The Council carefully reviewed the list of planning applications and unanimously supported the responses submitted to Wycombe District Council by the planning group.

A list of planning applications is circulated with the agenda for this meeting and is also posted on the Parish Notice Board in Bridge Street, Great Kimble, near the junction with the B4009 as are all statutory Parish Council notices.

## 5 Various BCC highways planning matters, including footways, footpaths, VETs (Village Entry Treatments), Vehicle Activated Sign/s and Buckinghamshire County Council Grass cutting.

A parishioner Roger Howgate has requested that the Parish Council support his observations and objection to the creation of a Byway Open to All Traffic on the Rights of Way (ROW) from the A4010 to Cadsden. The Parish Council unanimously agreed to this request and the Clerk was instructed to communicate this to the Planning Inspectorate.

**6 To review the applications for the parish councillor casual vacancy and decide which applicant to co-opt to the council.**

The Parish Council agreed to interview all applicants and vote on the most suitable applicant at the next Parish Council meeting on 10<sup>th</sup> March 2010.

**7 A resolution supporting the proposals from Hastoe Housing Trust for a supported housing development on the B4009 Grove Lane, Great Kimble opposite Grove Farm**

The Council decided NOT to support the proposals from Hastoe Housing Trust  
It was further agreed that a new partner be sought on the matter of supported housing in the parish

**8 The LTP3 Transport Planning consultation from Buckinghamshire County Council**

The date for submission of the parish's views on this plan has now EXPIRED; the delay in formally responding is due to the Council's timetable of meetings and the Christmas break.

**9 The Gypsy and Traveller proposals from Wycombe District Council**

A circular has been posted to all parishioners explaining the current developments and requesting support to resist any further Gypsy and Traveller sites in the parish.

**10 To review the accounts to December 2009 and approve all payments since the previous meeting, and to confirm end month bank balances (Accounts and payment list will be circulated prior to the meeting)**

The accounts were unanimously approved by the Council and signed by the Chairman and Clerk

**11 Reports from Councillors and Parish Clerk on various matters of interest including any correspondence on the following matters**

***a) Parish repairs (Councillor Alun Jones)***

Buckinghamshire County Council has been informed of the very bad situation in the parish on potholes following the bad weather over the Christmas period

***b) A report from Councillor David Williams (Vice Chairman) on the new website project***

The website should be active within the next 30 days.

***c) Kimble Stewart Hall a review of the future (Chairman)***

It was agreed that the Parish Council should look to establish a long term plan for Kimble Stewart Hall support.

***d) Public ROW Initiative by BCC (Walking Parish Footpaths)***

It was agreed that the Parish Council would support this plan.

***e) Consideration for Grant for Coombe Hill Memorial Appeal (Cllr S Watson)***

The Council agreed to grant £500.00 to this appeal.
