**Letter from The Rectory** 

Dear All. I can't believe how fast the year is going by! All of a sudden it is Autumn and during October we have our glorious Harvest Festival Celebrations. November has a very different feel as we honour the memory of those who 'for our tomorrow, gave their today' in our Remembrance Day Services on November 14th. Thinking about the contrasts between these occasions I was struck that they have 'thankfulness' in common. There is a story that tells of the thousands of children who were orphaned and left to starve during the bombing raids of World War II. The fortunate ones were rescued and placed in refugee camps where they received food and good care. But, many of these children who had lost so much could not sleep at night. They feared waking up to find themselves homeless again and without food. Nothing seemed to reassure them. Finally. someone hit upon the idea of giving each child a piece of bread to hold at bedtime. Holding their bread, these children could finally sleep in peace. All through the night the bread reminded the, 'today I ate and I will eat again tomorrow.' There is a beautiful and very simple book called 'Sleeping with Bread' written by the Linn family and based on this story. It encourages us to ask ourselves on a regular basis two questions: For what am I most grateful? For what am I least grateful? Prayerful people over many centuries have found direction for their days and their life by identifying these moments, maybe this could help us too Wishing you every blessing
